- 5 cans of cat food (pate type, tuna-sized can)
- 5 jars of baby food, chicken or turkey
- Dry cat food, Purina One Sensitive Systems or Gentle
- Dry kitten chow, Purina or Purina One
- Cat litter (any kind)
- Small chewy/moist dog treats
- Small container of cat nip
- Paper towels
- Disposable gloves (latex free, size medium or large)
- Anti-bacterial hand soap
- Hand sanitizer
- Bleach
- Dawn dish detergent
- Baking soda
- High efficiency laundry detergent
- Wild bird seed (for chickadees, nuthatch, & tufted titmouse)
